



Board Policy 803: Citizens Advisory Committees - Organization and Dissolution

Community Relations

The Board of Directors may appoint ad hoc Citizen Advisory Committees to study matters pertaining to Iowa Valley Community College District. Such committees will deal with specific issues as designated by the Board of Directors, and their responsibility will be fulfilled upon making a final report to the Board.

Selection of Citizen Advisory Committees will be made by the Board of Directors acting as a whole. Membership should be limited to individuals who are willing to devote time and attention to the matter under consideration. As a matter of basic policy such committees will be representative of the District and should, whenever possible, represent various director districts.

The chairperson of the committees will convene meetings of the membership and proceed with the work to be done. The chairperson will maintain liaison with the President and will be responsible for the preparation of a final report to be presented to the Board of Directors.

The report should contain the findings of the committee and, where appropriate, make suggestions or recommendations for consideration of the Board.
