



Board Policy 341: Student Participation in Governance

Administration

As constituents of the academic community, students can contribute to policy formulation and change. Students in college credit courses may pursue this through their elected representatives on designated committees of the College and through the Iowa Valley Community College District Board of Directors. Students in non-credit classes may pursue this through communication with employees of Iowa Valley Business and Community Solutions.

Student representation at Board meetings of Iowa Valley Community College District will be provided as follows: Marshalltown Community College and Ellsworth Community College – two representatives each from the student body appointed by their respective Student Senate or Council, Iowa Valley Business and Community Solutions – two representatives from Iowa Valley Business and Community Solutions appointed by the Vice President of Community and Business Solutions.
